# Professional Services Development Programme Level 1



### **Overview**

The Professional Services Development
Programme Level 1 (PSDP1) is a professional
development programme aimed at professional
services staff from across the University. The
purpose of the programme is to support
participants' career progression within the
University, as well as provide key skills to support
further development in the Higher Education
Sector.

Each session draws on the expertise of senior colleagues in the University. Participants are encouraged to input and take part in discussions.

Alongside the facilitated sessions, participants are required to undertake individual work between sessions. It is estimated that this will take around two hours per session.

A career development conversation between the participant and their line manager is also required between sessions 1 and 2.

#### **Duration**

Six sessions across five months.
